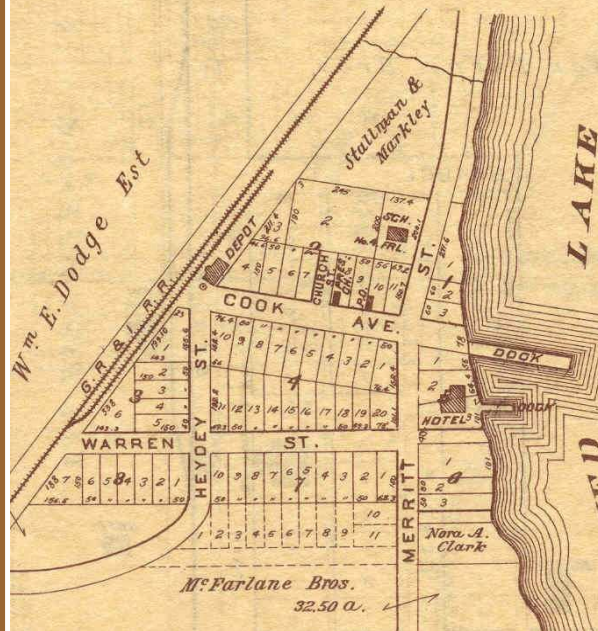
Crooked Lake...Begin Your Voyage

Crooked Lake, one of the finest fishing lakes in the Great Lakes State, boasts year-round fishing for walleye, pike, smallmouth bass, perch and panfish. With a boat launch 300 yards from the Inland House, a boating excursion couldn't be easier. Through the Inland Waterway, starting at Crooked Lake, one could cruise all the way to Lake Huron. This trip takes boaters through Round Lake, Iduna Creek, Crooked Creek, Burt Lake, Indian River, Mullett Lake and the Cheboygan River. Each year many pleasure boaters make the 76.4 mile round trip. It is not a trip to rush; plan to set aside an entire weekend to enjoy all that the Inland Waterway has to offer. Tourists have been drawn to the gorgeous waterway since 1873, when the rail to Conway opened up. It's attractions have not waned!

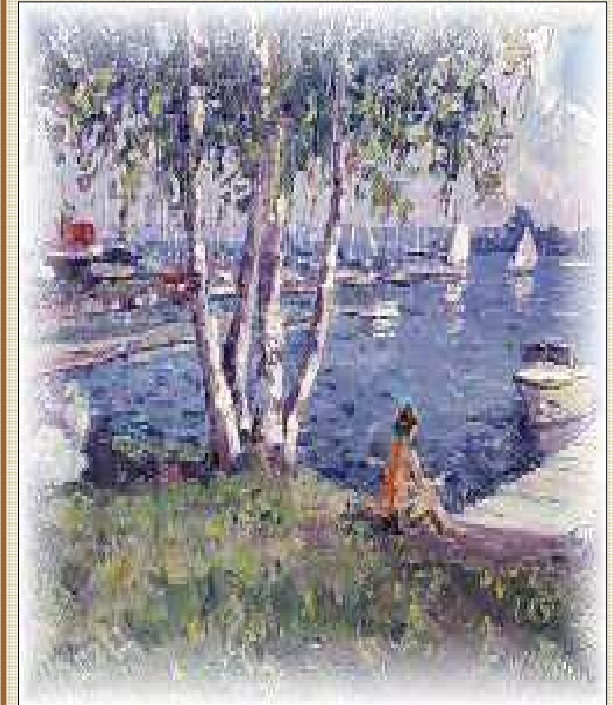
Conway was established in 1878 but did not always bear the same name. "Dodge's Landing" became Conway after the son of Mr. Dodge, Conway, died at the tender age of 11. the town was then renamed in his honor. Minutes from golf courses, ski resorts, snowmobile trails, restaurants and shopping, Conway is close to the excitement but far from the hustle and bustle of an average tourist town. This small Northern Michigan village frames the headwaters of the famed 43 mile Inland Waterway. Hot summer days see locals flock to the in-town community beach. Not in the mood for fun in the water? Take a hike or bike ride on the North Country Trail. Described by the Mountain Biking Michigan Guide Book as "Epic", it is an adventure one is not likely to soon forget!
